

Department of the Navy Lodging Privatization



The Department of the Navy is exploring options to privatize their lodging portfolio, which includes approximately 21,000 rooms at 45 Navy and 14 Marine Corps installations in the continental United States, Hawaii and Guam. The envisioned program would be executed in phases and would utilize the Alternative Authority for Acquisition and Improvement of Military Housing legislation, P.L. 104-106 Stat 186 Section 2801 (10 U.S.C. 2871-2885). To support this effort, the Department of the Navy is hosting an **Industry Forum** and requesting industry ideas using a **Request for Information (RFI)**.

The Industry Forum is planned for April 24, 2019. The Department of the Navy has released a Lodging Privatization Request for Information (RFI), which includes official notice of the Industry Forum and is available on FedBizOpps:
